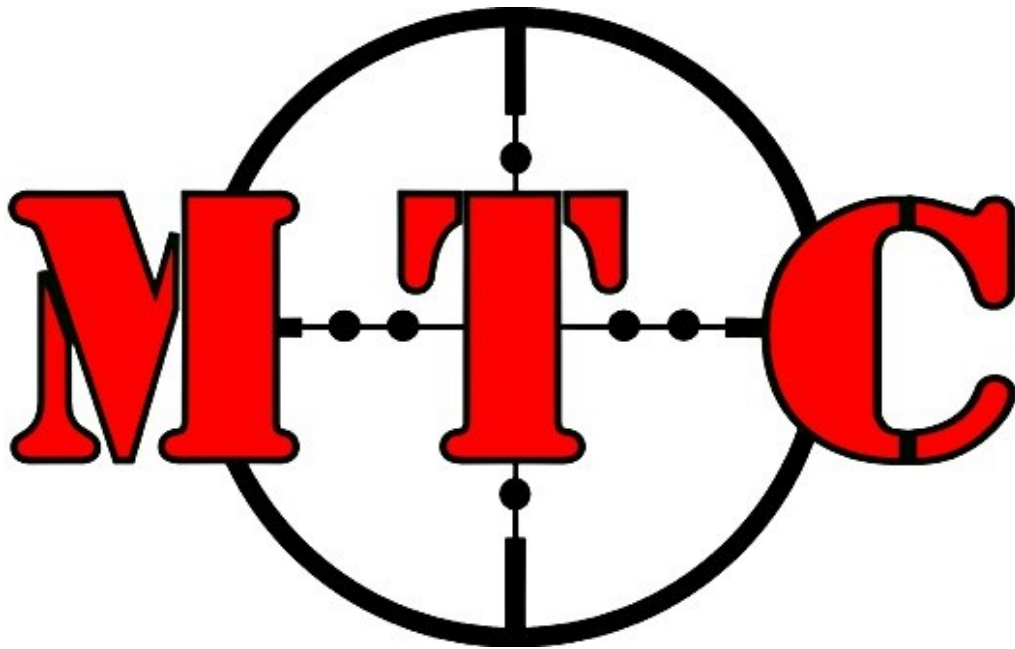

Range Rules and Regulations

The 4 universal firearms Safety Rules:

1. Treat every weapon as if it were loaded.
2. Never point a weapon at anything you do not intend to shoot. Know your target and its background.
3. Keep your weapon on safe until you are ready to fire.
4. Keep your finger straight and off the trigger until you *intend* to fire.

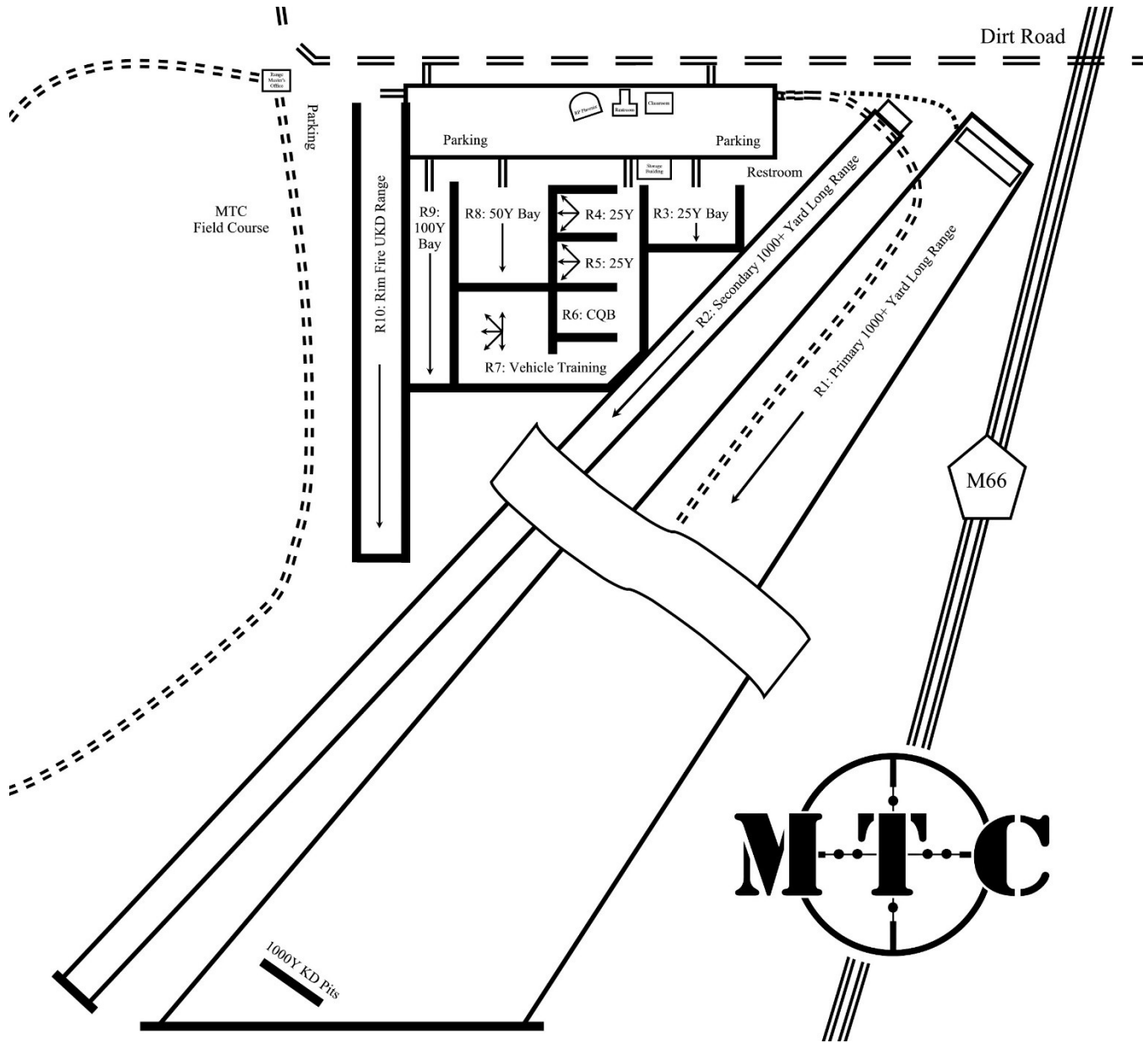
To discharge your firearm, you must:

1. Have a target - know your target.
2. Sight alignment and sight picture.
3. Conscious decision to destroy your target.

Common Range rules:

1. Recreational shooting times:
 - a. Suppressed weapons: Sunup till sundown.
 - b. Unsuppressed weapons: 0800 till 1900.
2. Closed gate policy:
 - a. For recreational shooting the gate will be closed behind the entering member, unless staff is on site.
 - b. For matches or events, the gate may remain open during registration. The gate should be closed before live fire begins, unless staff is on site.
3. Respect the facility. Malicious destruction of property will result in a permanent ban from the property.
4. Use the universal firearms safety rules ALWAYS. Gross violations may result in a permanent ban from the property.
5. No guests are allowed without prior approval from the Marksmanship Training Center.
6. Raise the RED range hot flag prior to using any range. Lower when range goes cold.
7. Firearms are to be loaded on the firing line with the weapon pointed down range.
8. Use of eye and ear protection is mandatory. The wearing of long sleeves, pants, and baseball cap is recommended.
9. Anyone may call "cease fire" when any unsafe condition occurs.
10. Every round you fire must strike inside the designated impact area downrange.
11. Use appropriate ammo and firearms on designated targets and ranges.
 - a. Use ball ammo on steel targets on the 25, 50, 100 yard ranges. Minimum distance of 10 yards for handgun, 100 yards for carbines.
 - b. Impact velocity must be below 3000fps for steel targets on all ranges - know your ballistic data.
 - c. Absolutely no steel core, AP or SLAP rounds on steel targets. (including 5.56 green tips)
 - d. Big bore shooters will use paper targets in the 100 yard bay to zero. Designated BMG square steel targets located on Range #1 at 300y, 550y, 700y and 1050 yards.
12. Wildlife are not authorized targets.
13. If there is no Range Officer on duty:
 - a. Use the range at your own risk during posted operating times of day.
 - b. All shooters are to remain behind the firing line while range is hot.
 - c. Unload all firearms while range is cold.
 - d. DO NOT touch or manipulate your weapon or sights while the range is cold.
14. Parents must supervise ALL dependents at ALL times.
 - a. Maintain a 1 guardian to 1 dependent ratio while engaged in ANY firearms handling.
 - b. Act as coach, mentor, and safety officer for dependent – Providing your undivided attention toward enforcing proper safety and marksmanship fundamentals.
15. Clean up after yourself. Leave the facility in a better state than when you arrived.
16. Keep off the berms. Impact and side berms are for your protection and are extremely expensive to repair after erosion.
17. Check range availability prior to coming to the range. Agencies may often "reserve" ranges. Scheduled competitions and training have priority over recreational shooting.

MTC Range specific rules:

Range #1 (primary long range) rules:

- Raise the RED range hot flag prior to using any range, and lower when range goes cold.
- Raise/lower the BLACK range flag prior to/after any down range movement. Also use “Personnel Down Range” sign.
 - Remember stow all flags and down range sign when vacating the range.
 - Ranges #1 and #2 both need to go cold for any down range movement.
 - Reserved ranges have the right of way. Recreational shooting yields to scheduled training and competitions.

- Clean up after yourself.
 - Take paper zero targets with you.
 - Clear the firing line of barricades & props.
 - Repaint targets as needed.
- Steel head and torso targets = 30 caliber and below.
- Steel square targets and paper targets = any caliber.
- You may load/unload gear in loading zone, but park your vehicle in the MTC parking lot.

Range #2 (secondary long range) rules:

- Raise the RED range hot flag prior to using any range, and lower when range goes cold.
- Raise/lower the BLACK range flag prior/after any down range movement. Also use “Personnel Down Range” sign.
 - Ranges #1 and #2 both need to go cold for any down range movement.
 - Reserved ranges have the right of way. Recreational shooting yields to scheduled training and competitions.
- When firing from inside the conex box, the muzzle must pass through the open window.
- Firing from the top level is not allowed except under special circumstances for events or training with staff approval and coordination.
- Clean up after yourself.
 - Repaint targets as needed.
- Steel targets = 30 caliber and below.

Range #3 (25y bay), #4 (25y bay), #5 (25y bay), #8 (50y bay) rules:

- Raise the RED range hot flag prior to using any range, and lower when range goes cold.
- Target stands for cardboard/paper, along with steel targets available in the target shed for recreational use.
- Clean up after yourself.
 - Return targets and barricade/props.
 - Repaint targets as needed.
- Steel targets:
 - Pistol ammo only (non magnum).
 - Minimum of 10 yards.
- Paper targets = No restrictions.

Range #6 (shoot house) rules:

- CQB House is not for recreational use.
- For authorized training with approved trainers / Range Safety Officers only.

Range #7 (vehicle dynamics bay) rules:

- For authorized training with approved trainers / Range Safety Officers only.
- Exceptions for MTC Members who:
 - Have a professional membership.
 - Have completed either Advanced Handgun (HG2) or Advanced Carbine (C2)

Range #9 (100y bay) rules:

- Raise the RED range hot flag prior to using any range, and lower when range goes cold.
- Target stands for cardboard/paper, along with steel targets available in the target shed for recreational use.
- Clean up after yourself.

- Return targets and barricade/props.
- Take paper zero targets with you.
- Steel targets:
 - Pistol ammo (non magnum) - Minimum of 10 yards.
 - Rifle ammo (less than 3000fps) - Minimum of 100 yards.
- Paper targets = No restrictions.

Initial _____

Range #10 (250y Small Bore Sniper) rules:

- Raise the RED range hot flag prior to using any range, and lower when range goes cold.
- ABSOLUTELY NO CENTER FIRE! Rim fire and small caliber air rifles only.
- Clean up after yourself.
 - Take paper zero targets with you.
 - Return temporary targets and barricade/props.
 - Repaint targets as needed.

Field Course rules:

- Run & Gun and Precision Rimfire Rifle stations are for Special Events Only.
- **WARNING!!!** There are live fire ranges in the immediate area. **STAY ON THE TRAIL**, with the exception of retrieving your arrow from the archery target. To avoid walking into danger areas, if you lose an arrow do not search further than 20 yards radius from the target. If multiple people are on the course, be courteous of other archer's time.
- ABSOLUTELY NO BROADHEADS!!! Field tips only!
- Targets are not rated for crossbows.

I acknowledge that exceptions to the range rules may be made at certain events, but that does not mean that unsupervised members may make the same exceptions on their own. No exceptions to the range rules can be made without staff approval and coordination.

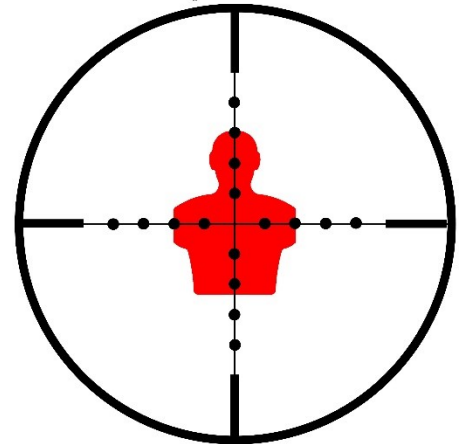

Special Notes:

- ⊕ For safety purposes, if you are unaware of your ballistic coefficient or are not familiar with MOA/Mil scope theory adjustments then you will need to attend our Long Rang Introductory Course prior to using the 1000 yard range.
- ⊕ You will need to know how to range targets at MTC, this is a **mandatory skill** needed for unescorted privileges on the UKD range. If you are unaware of the Mil-Dot range estimation formula, then you will need to attend our Long Rang Introductory Course prior to using the 1000 yard range.
- ⊕ You may conduct cold bore data collection and grouping test on paper targets at the 100 yard range.
- ⊕ For your first visit to the range confirm scope data with **closest targets first**, and then work your way out further confirming data. Do not attempt a 1000 yard cold bore shot the first day at the range.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK, RELEASE & INDEMNITY AGREEMENT (“AGREEMENT”)

I, _____, hereby acknowledge that I have voluntarily applied to enter on to and to engage in or to observe shooting and other activities at the Marksmanship Training Center (the “RANGE”) of Global Independent, LLC. I further acknowledge and understand that “shooting and other activities” includes any and all activities of any kind whatsoever in which I engage or observe while at the RANGE, whether sponsored by Global Independent, LLC or not.

I ACKNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTAND THAT SHOOTING ACTIVITIES ARE INHERENTLY HAZARDOUS and involve both known and unanticipated risks which could result in damage or destruction of property and physical or emotional injury, including paralysis or death, of myself or of other persons. I FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTAND THAT the nature and condition of the RANGE facilities, premises and environment is such that both known and unanticipated hazards exist which create or contribute to both known and unanticipated risks inherent in entering on to the RANGE, in using RANGE facilities and in engaging in or observing any activities of any kind whatsoever while at the RANGE. The hazards include, but are not limited to: slippery, loose or falling soil and rocks; unimproved, unmaintained, or uneven terrain, walkways, steps and roads; poisonous or dangerous plants, reptiles, insects and other animals; and falling trees and tree branches. **I understand that such hazards and risks cannot be eliminated without compromising the essential qualities of the RANGE facilities, equipment, premises and environment.** INITIAL _____
